Home Activities:

- Help elderly neighbors with small tasks.
- Visit senior homes to play games with residents.
- Join parents in driving elderly residents to appointments.
- Call or write letters to grandparents.

Families & Babies 1st Grade



1st graders will focus on helping families in need, particularly those with babies.

Home Activities:

- Adopt a family for holiday gifting.
- Make Mother's Day cards for various organizations.
- Volunteer at organizations like Any Baby Can.

Refugees 2nd Grade



2nd graders will serve local refugee families, fostering empathy for displaced families.

Home Activities:

- Donate items to More Than A Welcome to help refugees settle.
- Pray for displaced families.
- Learn about and explore different cultures.

Orphans 3rd Grade



3rd graders will focus on supporting orphans and children in foster care.

Home Activities:

- Make freezer meals for ministries like Table of Grace.
- Donate to Texas Baptist Children's Home.
- Adopt a child from Pop-Up Birthday and send a birthday box.

The Homeless 4th Grade



4th graders will serve those experiencing homelessness.

Home Activities:

- Join MLF truck teams or serve at Angel House Soup Kitchen.
- Make and deliver freezer sandwiches for Street Youth Ministry.
- Visit Community 1st! Village for events.

Feeding the Mind 5th Grade



5th graders will focus on literacy and helping others through reading.

Home Activities:

- Donate books to Little Libraries or BookSpring.
- Collect and distribute religious books to local churches.

Feeding the Body 6th Grade



6th graders will serve by working in community gardens and food pantries.

Home Activities:

- Participate in community gardening.
- Serve at local food pantry Hungry Souls.
- Help with grocery shopping and budgeting.
